If you would like to place a memorial plaque in the sanctuary for a loved one, please contact the temple office. While engraving of plaques takes several weeks, we would be pleased to include the name in this year's book if we have the information by the above deadline. This is one way to fulfill the mitzvah of honoring those who have passed on: a deed of loving kindness, which perpetuates a loved one's memory while investing in our holy space.
